## Curriculum Vitae

Dr. Tim Ostermann has been a member of the German Bundestag since 2013 as part of the CDU/CSU parliamentary group. As a member of the Internal Affairs Committee he serves as the rapporteur for General IT Policy and IT Strategy of the Federal Government, for Constitutional Law and Fundamental Rights as well as Civic Education and Statistics. Ostermann is a substitute member of the Transport and Digital Infrastructure Committee and the Inquiry Committee "NSA". He is also a member of the Working Group on Communal Affairs and the Group of Young Members.

Since 1995 Ostermann has been a member of the CDU and since 2002 he has been a member of the city council in his home town Löhne. He was elected chairman of the CDU in the district of Herford in 2012 and has been serving as deputy chairman of the CDU regional association of Ostwestfalen-Lippe since 2014.

Ostermann was born in 1979 in Bünde, is married and father of two children. After passing the second state bar exam and finishing his Juridical Doctorate at the University of Bielefeld, he has been working as an attorney at law since 2008 in Herford.
